**the flowers** The bridesmaids' carried a simple bouquet of burgundy and white calla lilies with green berzillia berries.

**the reception** The rustic reception venue was decorated with deep purple table runners and classic white tiffany chairs.

**the dress** The white wedding dress was made from dupon silk and designed around a neckline, which was altered into two straps and featured at the front. Carrie's naturally curly hair was swept into a half upstyle with a complementing brooch.

**the centrepiece** Single blooms of phalaenopsis and mokara orchids were placed in a tall vase, surrounded by short arrangements of berzillia berries and striking Green Trick balls.

**the stationery** Designed by the bride's stepmother, who is a passionate card maker, the wedding stationery matched the wedding's colour theme. Table numbers were displayed in silver frames, and the quirky seating chart was presented at the entrance.
